



A Tough Fescue with Soft Leaves

Bronson Tall Fescue exhibits the toughness that you have come to expect in a forage tall fescue, but with softer leaves than many common varieties. Bronson withstands tough growing conditions that are common on most farms; drought, heat and grazing are all handled well by Bronson!

Forage quality tests taken on May 24, 2000 from samples retrieved from the University of Wisconsin shows Bronson Tall Fescue to have good feed value and digestibility as seen in the chart below.
