Kentucky Bluegrass

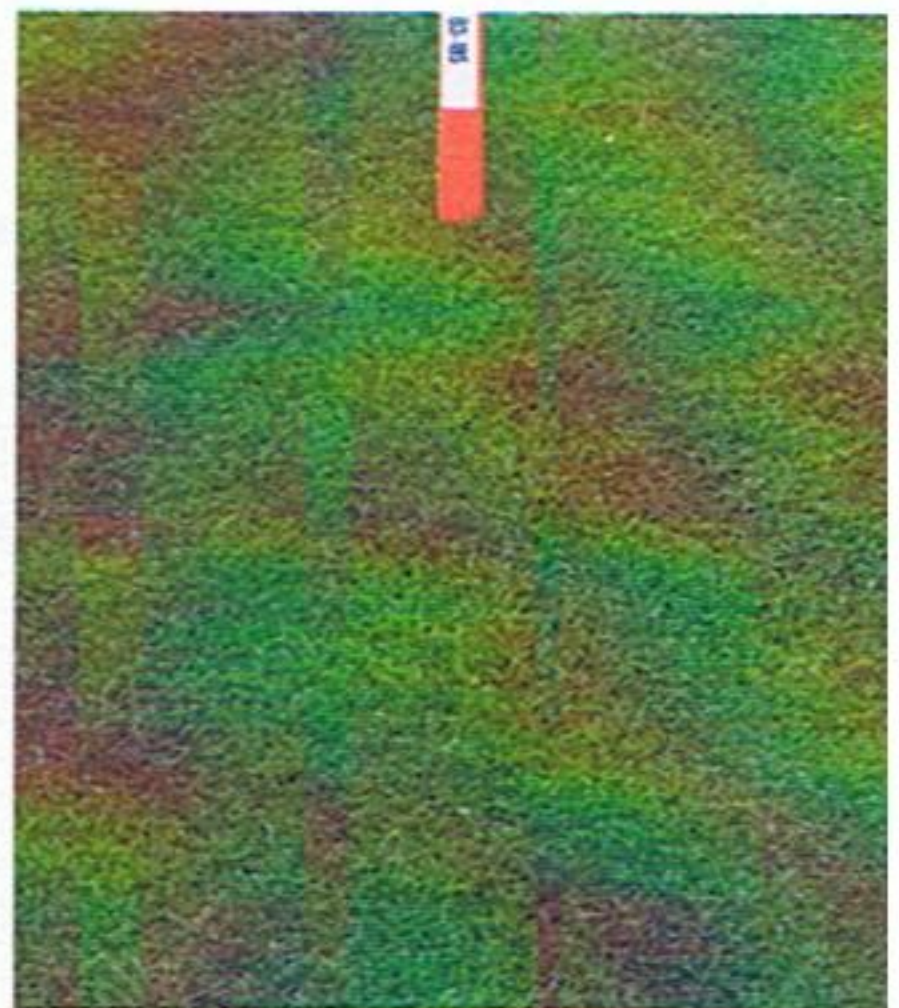
- Elite widely adaptable variety

Dynamo Kentucky bluegrass is an elite fine leaved turf variety that is a cross of Blacksburg and Unique turf varieties developed by Pure Seed Testing, Inc. Dynamo thrives under short cut, high maintenance golf fairway and sports turf regimes. The variety has traits that also offers very good low maintenance performance. With improved shade tolerance and powdery mildew resistance, Dynamo mixes well with Midnight types to give a nice genetic balance for sports turf and sod mixes.

Classified as a compact America type, Dynamo Kentucky bluegrass was developed to provide a medium dark green plant with high shoot density. It has a short growth habit, good wear tolerance and color retention. The variety greens up in early spring and retains its color later through the growing season. Dynamo Kentucky bluegrass is a very nice looking turf cultivar with good seedling vigor and high sod strength. These attributes make Dynamo a superb variety that is widely adaptable to use in mixes for sod production, commercial and home turf, and sports field use.

Improved disease resistance is an advantage of Dynamo. It shows excellent resistance to powdery mildew, summer patch and dollar spot diseases. The variety ranked in the top ten, and as high as #1 in shade trials conducted at University of Illinois NTEP testing recently. Dynamo will perform well when cut as low as ½ inch, but is easily adaptable to a 2 ½ inch height of cut.

New Lawns: 2 to 3# per 1000 square feet
Overseed: 1 to 1.5# per 1000 square feet
