**Rogue forage tall fescue** is a new development from the WPI Group. Rogue has held it's own in forage trials— across the U.S and Canada. It is a persistent, good establishing tall fescue. Because of its good establishment – Rogue will produce a better than average stand.

Rogue Tall fescue is a deep-rooted, tufted, long-lived perennial with numerous dark green leaves and a few to many seed stalks; it grows 3 to 4 feet high. The panicles are 4 to 12 inches long. Short-awned seeds are borne 5 to 7 in the spikelet. There are about 220,000 seeds per pound.

Rogue, if properly managed and fertilized, is as palatable and nutritious and as usable as other species of forage grasses. An important feature of Rogue tall fescue is its wide adaptation. It will grow on a wide variety of soils from highly acid to highly alkaline, which is probably the widest range of any commonly grown grass species. Adaptation to a wide range of soil conditions.
