Variety Information:

Early Type:

Typically 7 to 10 days earlier than Climax Timothy. Saddlebred Timothy has been bred in competition with other grasses and legumes; therefore, making it reliable in all grass mixes.

Disease Resistant:

Saddlebred Timothy is highly resistant to leaf rust, leaf spot and purple eyespot.

Seeding:

Seed Saddlebred Timothy at 12lbs/acre in pure stands and a minimum of 6lbs/acre in mixtures.

Plant Saddlebred Timothy in a fine, firm seed bed, preferably no deeper than ¼ inch.

Harvesting:

For top quality production, harvest Saddlebred Timothy at the late shot-blade to early heading stage.
